	he	plays		he	played	
	she	plays		she	played	
	we	play		we	played	
	they	play		they	played	
	I	like		I	liked	
	you	like		you	liked	
	she	likes		she	liked	
	he	likes		he	liked	
we	like	we	liked			
they	like	they	liked

every day	I	don't like		I	didn't like.	yesterday no <u>-ed</u> for <u>like</u>
	You	don't like		You	didn't like.	
	He	doesn't like		He	didn't like.	
	She	doesn't like		She	didn't like.	
	We	don't like		We	didn't like.	
	They	don't like		They	didn't like.
